



Hui Kwok Leong is currently with the National University of Singapore Enterprise Cluster and is a key member of the NUS team that looks into incubating, funding and nurturing NUS related early stage high-tech startup companies. He was instrumental in raising over \$8.4 million in external funding for startups under the NUS investment portfolio, and the catalyst for acquisition of a NUS portfolio company by a leading education company in Singapore. Kwok Leong was the founding CEO of NexusEdge Technologies Pte Ltd, a technology spin-off company from Kent Ridge Digital Labs (currently known as I²R of A*STAR). NexusEdge has attracted over S\$2.5m investment from angel and venture capitalists over a 3 year period. Kwok Leong also co-founded a number of other technology and education startups that are currently operating profitably. Prior to this, Kwok Leong was the center manager of Java Resource Center at Kent Ridge Digital Labs, a multi-million dollar technology center by SUN Microsystems Singapore and IDA. Kwok Leong grew the team of Java architects and technologists working on various large national level projects such as the EduPad project and also with Ericsson CyberLab. The centre grossed over \$2million in consultancy revenue. He is a Tan Kah Kee Young Inventor Silver award winner and a co-inventor of a key international software patent for Nexusedge. He has over 17 years of experience in ICT, specializing in advanced software technologies and management. He holds a Master and Honors Degree in Computer Science from the National University of Singapore.
